## Leaving a Gift in Your Will

Thank you for considering a gift to Haematology Cancer Care. Your generosity can make a lasting difference to the lives of people affected by blood cancers and disorders.

There are two main ways you can leave a gift to support our work:

1. A Share of Your Estate (Residuary Gift)

You can choose to leave us a percentage of what remains of your estate after family and friends have been provided for. Many supporters prefer this option, as it keeps pace with inflation and ensures your gift reflects the value of your estate over time.

Suggested wording:

“I give all (or a % share) of the residue of my estate to UCLH Charity (registered charity no 1165398, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor East, 250 Euston Road, London NW1 2PG) for the benefit of **fund 0099, Haematology Cancer Care**, and I direct that the receipt of a duly authorised officer shall be a valid and appropriate form of discharge.”

2. A Fixed Sum (Pecuniary Gift)

Alternatively, you may prefer to leave a specific amount of money. Please note that a fixed sum may lose value over time due to inflation.

Suggested wording:

“I give the sum of £.... (amount in figures and words) to UCLH Charity (registered charity no 1165398, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor East, 250 Euston Road, London NW1 2PG) for the benefit of **fund 0099, Haematology Cancer Care**, and I direct that the receipt of a duly authorised officer shall be a valid and appropriate form of discharge.”
